### TRAVEL INFO:

1. For Playa del Carmen, travel to Cancun international airport. Once you arrive at the airport and clear customs and get your luggage, you can take a free shuttle bus to Terminal 2 where you can catch an ADO Bus direct from the airport to the terminal in Playa del Carmen for a mere \$100 pesos. The bus leaves every hour but if you are arriving very early or very late, you may have to take a shuttle or a taxi.
2. Once you arrive at the Playa del Carmen bus terminal, you can take a taxi to the hotel, which should cost no more than 20 pesos. You can also walk, but hiring a bicycle driver for your luggage is recommended. Its about a 10 to 15 minute walk from the bus terminal to the hotel.
3. To return to Cancun airport you can take the same ADO bus, but you can also take a taxi. A taxi back to the airport is NOT the same price as a taxi from the airport – its only about \$450 pesos to get from Playa to Cancun and about 5 times as much the other way.
4. Generally speaking, you will get better rates if you pay in pesos. Sergio will change Canadian or US dollars into pesos for you at mid-market rates which are better than what you will get at the bank or the currency exchange. It also saves you the trouble of bringing a large amount of cash with you. But do pre-book! Credit cards will be widely accepted in Playa but taxis are cash only. Canadian dollars are not generally accepted.
5. The hotel has free wireless internet for communicating with the folks back home. Leave your cell phone at home unless you can buy a local GSM chip for it. Sergio's cellphone in Mexico is:
